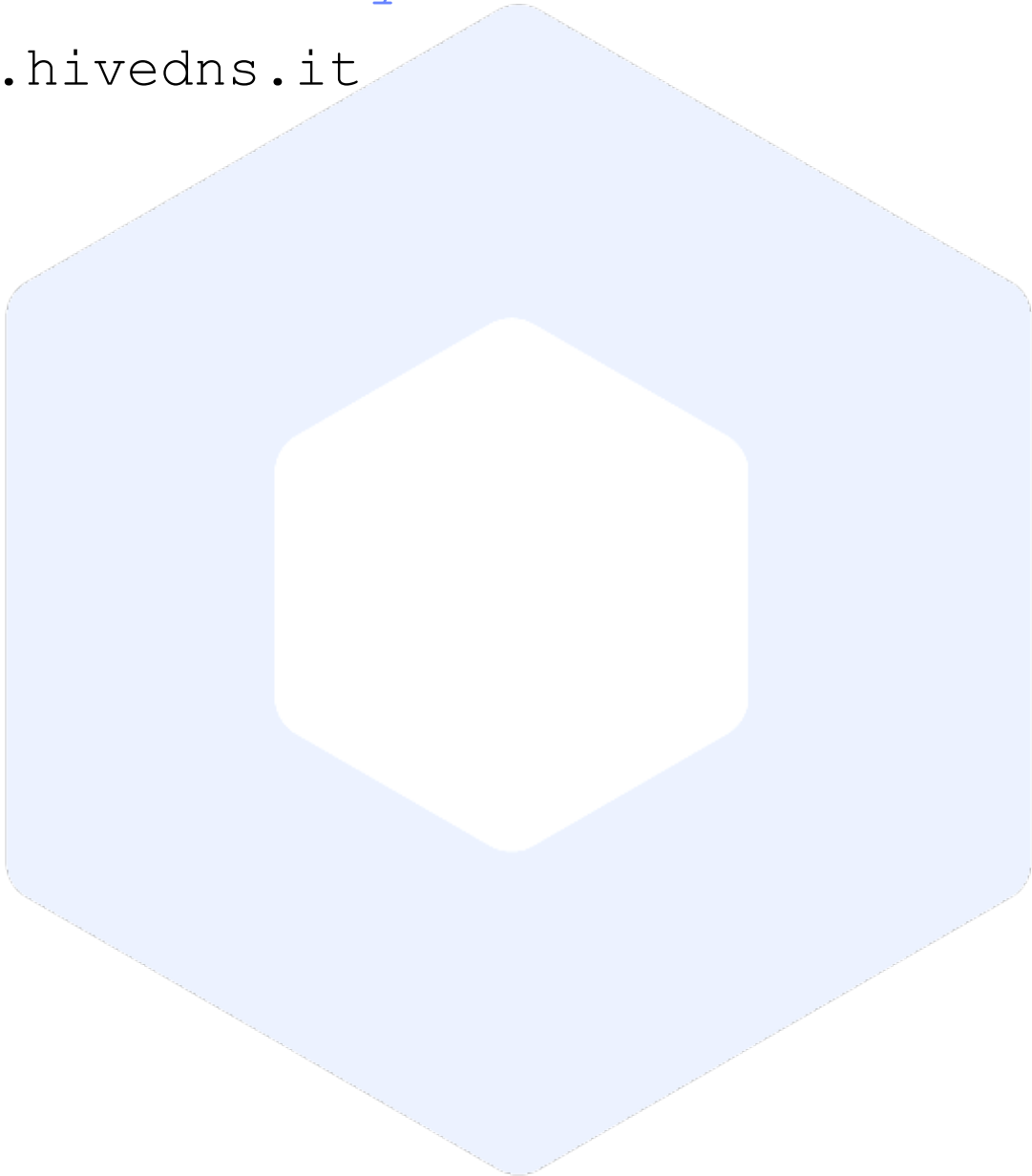

1 Introduction

The purpose of this Cookie Policy is to disclose the procedures followed for the collection, through cookies and/or other tracking technologies, of information provided by users when they visit this website at www.nethive.it.

2 General information about cookies and other tracking technologies

We use cookies in some areas of our site. Cookies are files that store information on your hard drive or browser. They allow this site to check whether you have already visited the site. Cookies allow us to understand which pages of the site are most visited because they allow us to see which pages are visited and for how long. Through this data we are able to make the site more responsive to your requests and easier to navigate. For example, cookies allow us to ensure that the information on the site on your future visits is tailored to your preferences.

You can configure your browser to accept all cookies, refuse all cookies, or notify you when a cookie has been sent. Each browser is different, so please click on the "HELP" menu on your browser to understand how to change your cookie preferences. For example, in Microsoft Internet Explorer, you can disable or delete cookies by selecting "Tools/Internet Options" and change your privacy settings or by selecting "delete cookies". However, please note that this site has been designed to use cookies and any uninstallation of cookies may affect the operation of the site and will not allow the best use of the site.

We do not exchange cookies with external sites or external data providers.

3 General information on the rules regarding consent to the use of cookies

The Italian and European legislation (art. 122 of Legislative Decree 101/18) has introduced in our system a European Directive that requires operators of websites that use cookies or other monitoring technologies to inform the user about the types of cookies used by the site.

The Italian Supervisory Authority decree n. 229 of 8 May 2014, published in the G.U. n. 126 of 3 June 2014, has categorized cookies in two macro-categories: "technical" cookies and "profiling" cookies.

- **Technical Cookies**

Technical cookies are those used for the sole purpose of "transmitting a communication over an electronic communication network, or to the extent strictly necessary for the provider of an information society service explicitly requested by the subscriber or user to provide such service" (see art. 122, paragraph 1, of the Code).

They are not used for further purposes and are normally installed directly by the owner or operator of the website. They can be divided into browsing or session cookies, which guarantee normal navigation and use of the website (allowing, for example, to make a purchase or authenticate to access reserved areas);



analytics cookies, similar to technical cookies when used directly by the site manager to collect information, in aggregate form, on the number of users and how they visit the site itself; functionality cookies, which allow the user to navigate according to a series of selected criteria (for example, language, products selected for purchase) in order to improve the service provided to the same.

No prior user consent is required for the installation of such cookies.

- **Profiling cookies**

Profiling cookies are designed to create profiles related to the user and are used to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user when surfing the web. Due to the particular invasiveness that such devices may have within the privacy of users, European and Italian legislation provides that the user must be adequately informed about their use and thus express their valid consent.

Art. 122 of the Code refers to them where it provides that "the storage of information in the terminal equipment of a contractor or user or access to information already stored is allowed only on condition that the contractor or user has expressed his consent after having been informed in the simplified manner referred to in Article 13, paragraph 3" (Art. 122, paragraph 1, of the Code).

In the same Measure, the Guarantor has also categorized cookies according to the subject who operates as the owner of the processing of personal data collected by the cookie, distinguishing between first party cookies and third party cookies.

1. **First party cookies**

These are the cookies managed by the owner of the site. For these cookies, the obligation to provide information lies with the owner of the site. It is also up to the site owner to indicate how the cookie can be blocked.

2. **Third party cookies**

These are cookies managed by a third party other than the owner of the site. For these cookies, the obligation to provide information and to indicate how to block the cookie, if any, lies with the third party, while the owner of the site is obliged to insert a link to the site of the third party where these elements are available.

In both types of cookies (first-party or third-party) the collection of consent, which is necessary if the cookie is a profiling cookie, is done through a special banner on the home page of the site.

4 Characteristics of cookies used by this website

At the bottom of this Cookie Policy is a list of all cookies used by this website.

In the first group are listed the so-called technical cookies whose use does not require the user's consent.

If present on this website, in the second group are listed the profiling cookies.

For both groups, the following information is listed for each type of cookie:

- Cookie name
- Cookie function
- Indication whether the cookie is first or third party

- If the cookie is first party cookie, indication of how to block it
- If the cookie is a third party cookie, indication of the link through which it is possible to reach the site of the third party where the third party's information about the processing of personal data collected through the cookie is reported and how to block the cookie.

Please note that any blocking of technical cookies may affect the functionality of this website
